Dear Parents,

We are off to an excellent 2019-2020 school year. In our class, your child will be using technology integrated curriculum so he/she will learn using a chrome book. It is imperative that your child bring their charged chromebooks each and every day. All tests and assignments are done electronically and if they have no computer that day they will receive a score of zero for that day. Students also need to arrive to school every day with their binder, some sharpened pencils, and their completed homework. Every morning your child will be taught social skills for the first fifteen minutes of class which will support your child in having positive behavior. Our goal is that our students will not receive any yellow tickets or referrals so they can attend end of the school year activities such as field day. Each trimester your child will practice earning a reward activity. The last trimester will be the most strict, especially since they have been practicing all year to earn the end of year rewards. Let's support your child in reaching this goal!

### **CLASSROOM REWARDS**

1. Praise/phone call or notes home +1 or more points

### **PRINCIPAL'S REWARDS**

1. Starbucks
2. Bucket filler weekly raffle
3. Weekly and monthly attendance rewards

### **CLASSROOM CONSEQUENCES**

1. 1<sup>st</sup> Warning - gentle in-class reminder
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Warning - Time out/reflection sheet
3. 3<sup>rd</sup> Warning - 1st - 3rd Low Level Referral w/reflection and parent contact
4. 4th Low Level Referral - parent conference
5. 5th Low Level Referral - turns into an office referral (ODR)

### **PLAYGROUND/MPR CONSEQUENCES**

1. Yellow Ticket for outside behavior
2. Yellow ticket turns into a low level referral
3. 3rd yellow ticket = removal from playground

### **HOMEWORK**

Homework is given every day (Monday –Friday). Homework is a review of what we have already taught. Your child has been taught how to complete it. If they need assistance, they should research the skill on their chromebooks. Please make sure it is neat and completed each night. Students should also read their library book, or another book, for 30 minutes every night. Students who do not turn in their homework will be given an opportunity to complete it during their recess. If they choose to not complete their homework at night or during their recess, they will receive a Low Level Referral. All test scores will be recorded in your child's data binder for you to inspect weekly.
